

The Classics Department, Royal Holloway, is pleased to announce the following AHRC Departmental and Faculty scholarships.

The Department welcomes application from suitably qualified candidates who wish to study in any research area in Classical Studies and Classical Reception. For research activity in the Department see <http://www.rhul.ac.uk/classics/research/index.html> , www.crgr.org, and individual staff web pages. The awards are either competitive across the Faculty, and awarded at the discretion of the Dean, or are competitive within the Department, and awarded by the Departmental Graduate Studies committee in consultation with the Dean.

1. AHRC doctoral scholarship (fees + bursary) – 1 award

Departmental Scholarship: This scholarship will be awarded to the strongest qualified candidate by the Departmental Graduate Studies Committee. The award is subject to the proper subsequent completion of AHRC's documentation, and to the approval of the AHRC.

2. Reid Scholarship (HEU Fee Waiver + £13,250) – 4 Awards in total

Faculty scholarship: Awards will be made to the four strongest candidates across the Arts Faculty at the discretion of the Dean.

3. College Maintenance Grants (£6,000) – 1 Award

Departmental Scholarship. This scholarship will be awarded to the strongest candidate (after nominations to larger scholarships) by the Departmental Graduate Studies Committee

3. Crossland Scholarship (£5,000) – 1 Award

Departmental Scholarship: This scholarship will be awarded to the strongest candidate (after nominations to larger scholarships) by the Departmental Graduate Studies Committee.

4. College Research Scholarships – (HEU Fee Waiver)— 3 awards

Departmental Scholarship: These scholarships will be awarded to the strongest candidates (after nominations to larger scholarships) by the Departmental Graduate Studies Committee.

A preliminary ranking for the award of scholarship by the Departmental Graduate Studies Committee will take place in the middle of March using the standard RHUL M.Phil./Ph.D. application forms. **Candidates are advised that to guarantee that their application be considered, applications must be with the College Admissions Office by 8th March.** Information as to the success of applications should become available by early May.
