




Getting more data on mobile devices for students

The government is working with a number of networks to help students get more data allowance on their mobile devices so that they can access remote education. Schools, trusts and local authorities can request increases for some students. The following networks currently in the scheme are: Three, Smarty, Virgin Mobile, EE, Tesco Mobile, and Sky Mobile.

Type in 'Gov add mobile data' to Google and click on the link with the title 'Increasing data allowances...'
