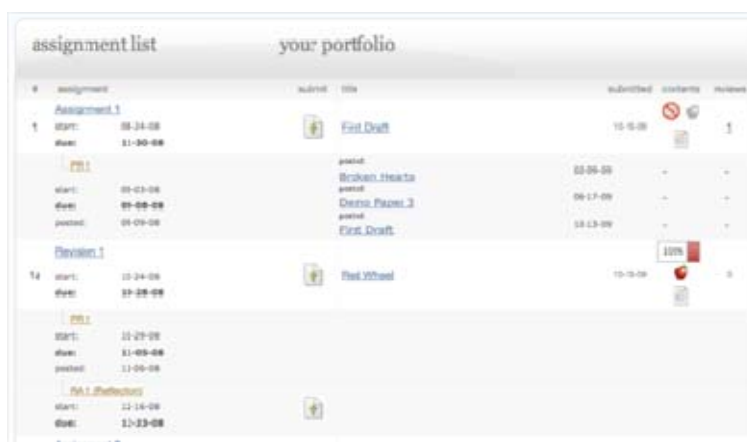

### Description of what's new

The redesigned student dashboard will help students keep better track of their assignments and provide easy access to important functions.

### How is it Different than the Previous Version?

- View assignments grouped into coloured bands
- Click the link "Show Details" to see additional information about the assignment or to access Originality Reports and marked papers. (Formerly, they would click the assignment title link for more information.)
- See a status indicator that lets them know the status of their papers and the assignment.
- See Submit and Resubmit buttons only when these options are available. The buttons have text rather than being an image of a paper with an upward pointing arrow.
